## **Redford Union District Bond Renovations Near Completion**

As Redford Union students headed back to class, they were welcomed by a few new features as bond construction projects wrap up. From the completion of the new Bob Atkins Field at our Secondary Campus, to a refinished and rebuilt pick-up, drop-off, and parking area at Beech Elementary, and extensive interior renovations and exterior additions at Hilbert Elementary, students and staff were once again welcomed to upgraded facilities for the 2024/2025 school year.

Since receiving funds from the 2021 bond initiative, RUSD has been working hard to see construction projects through at all District buildings where programs are in place.

Hilbert Elementary students and staff saw substantial improvements made to the interior of their building. Among the changes, the halls received new flooring, a fresh coat of paint, upgrades to classroom ventilation units, and significant renovation to the buildings restrooms and media center.

RUSD's Secondary Campus saw multiple improvement projects with the addition of a new gymnasium, team/locker rooms, weight room and an Early College & Careers program space. These new additions offer Panther students additional resources to further their educational experience. The high school portion of the Secondary Campus also now features a Main Street entrance and adjacent multi-purpose room, which will serve as a hub for students to enjoy during and outside the school day.

Finally, the long-awaited on-campus stadium - Bob Atkins Field – and outdoor plaza is now open and saw the Redford Union Panthers Varsity Football Team defeat the Romulus Eagles in their first home game of the season.
