Protocols & Mitigation Measures

- 1. Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) (masks, face-shields, hand-sanitizer, desk guards, etc.) will be available for use by students & staff.
- 2. To begin the school year, students and staff will be required to properly wear masks while sharing/occupying instructional spaces and common-use areas (shared spaces) indoors within District buildings and on District busses. This initial requirement will be reconsidered periodically based upon trends within both Wayne County and Redford Township and any other pertinent guidance or County, State, or Federal mandates, when/if provided.
- 3. Daily Screening will be required of staff & asked of students/families per guidance from Wayne County Health Division (WCHD). (Note: Staff screening is to be completed using the District-provided ClearToGo! app.)
- 4. District will continue to work closely with representatives from the WCHD as it pertains to isolation, quarantine, and/or contact tracing.



Protocols & Mitigation Measures (cont.)

- 5. Air Scrubbers, box fan systems, and windows (weather permitting) will continue to be utilized to promote improved ventilation & air quality for staff & students.
- **6. Social-Distancing** will be promoted & considered whenever practical within both **classrooms** and **common-use indoor areas.**
- 7. Cohorting of students will be promoted & considered whenever practical.
- 8. Cleaning protocols will continue to be followed to address hard surfaces within instructional spaces and common-use indoor areas.
- **9. Athletic offerings** for student-athletes and **games/contests** for fans, staff, and student-athletes **will continue to follow** any applicable **MHSAA and/or Conference requirements.**
