Benefits of being in the Young Fives Program

Student builds a strong foundation in essential learning skills in reading and math for Kindergarten.

Student becomes familiar with building procedures and staff.

Student creates friendships with students that could last through their primary education.

Student becomes comfortable with full day procedures such as using the cafeteria and switching classrooms for specials.

Student takes part in school wide assemblies, field trips, and field day activities!

Program has fall and spring conferences along with a Semester report card in January and June.

Program contains quarterly assessments to keep parents informed of academic progress.

Students given the gift of time to grow an additional year before beginning Kindergarten.

Our program is designed to build a strong foundation of these essential readiness skills within a child centered learning community.



WAIVER REQUEST

Children must be five years old between July 1st and September 1st to be eligible for this program



If your child is NOT 5 years old by September 1st, but will be by December 1st,

(5th birthday is between September 2nd-December 1st)
