Special Needs Transportation

The Redford Union Schools provides transportation for Special Needs Students based on information relayed in a student's "IEP." The Transportation Department only receives limited information about each student including the school the child will attend, eligibility for transportation, specific medical needs or allergies.

Our staff members receive training and support on working with Special Needs students and we welcome additional information you wish to share that may help us provide a pleasant experience for your child. For example, if your child is combative about their bus ride but enjoys glossy magazines, we will do our best to provide a suitable distraction that will lessen their emotional discomfort on the bus. Our bus drivers and bus aides want to provide the safest and best service possible.

Our buses will visit each regularly scheduled stop on a daily basis per the routing information you receive from our office. However, after three days of stopping with no activity from your child, we will discontinue service at your stop. You must call our office at 313-242-4400 to resume service.
